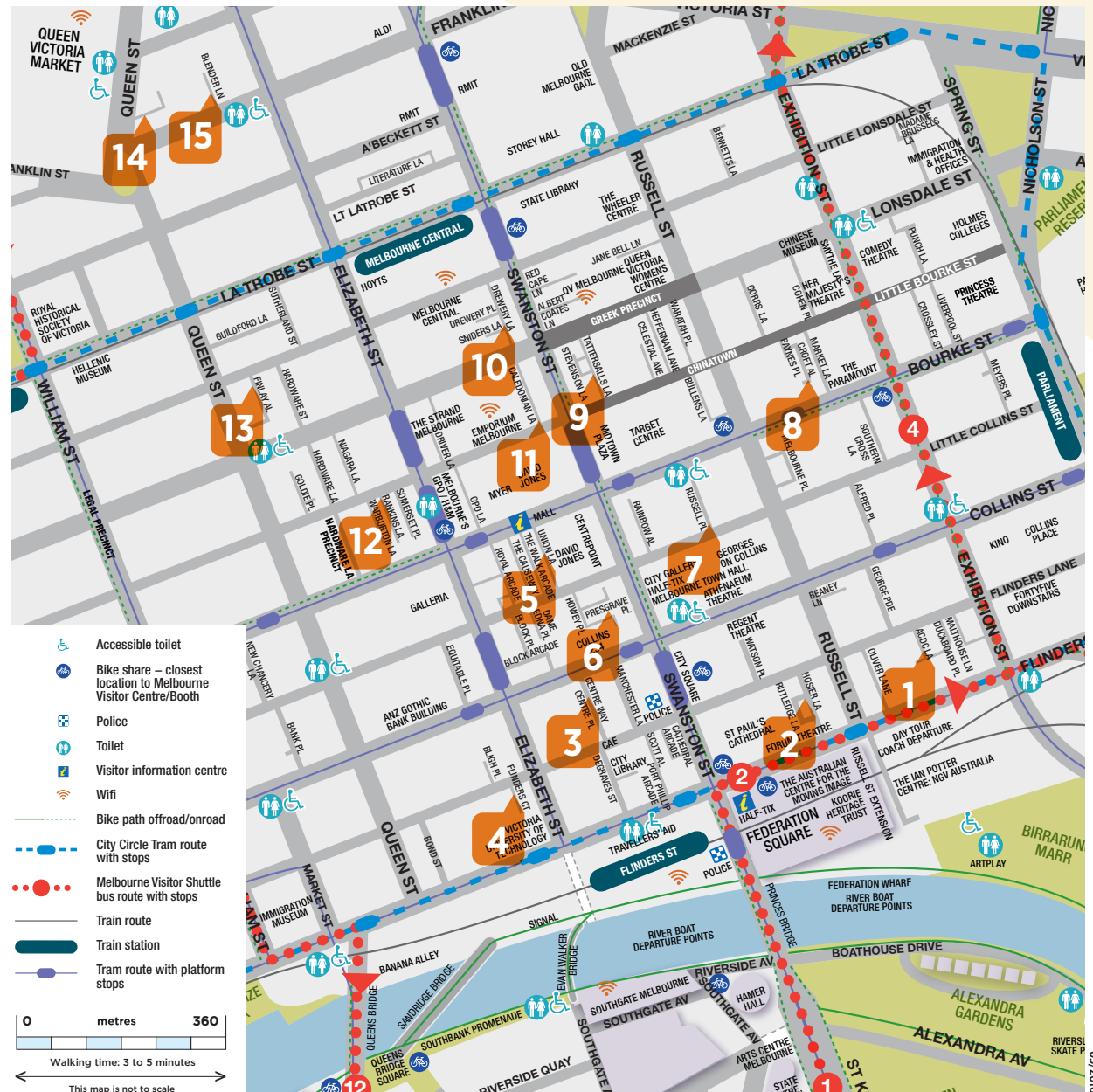


STREET ART IN MELBOURNE
